- 4> Brett Hull - Brett Hull scored 741 regular season goals during his career. Only Gordie Howe (801) and Wayne Gretzky (894) scored more.
- 5> Russia - Largely responsible for Germany's defeat, Russia had over 21 million casualties during the war.
- 6> Dr Pepper - Charles Aderton invented 'Dr Pepper' in Waco, Texas in 1885.
- 7> 118 - Currently, scientists know of 118 different elements with the latest being discovered in 2010.
- 8> Birdman - Michael Keaton plays the role of Riggan Thomson, a failing Hollywood actor.
- 9> Thomas Harris - All of Thomas' novels have been made into films.
- 10> 1973 - The original World Trade Center featured landmark twin towers.
- 11> Op Art - Bridget currently lives and works in London.
