- 1> San Francisco - Nob Hill was originally called California Hill.

- 4> Canada - Indonesia has the second longest coastline at 54,716 km.
- 5> Bering Strait - The Bering Strait is about 51 miles wide at its narrowest point.
- 6> Red, White, Green - The flag was adopted in June of 1946.
- 7> Amazon River - The Nile is 41, 390 miles long and runs through ten countries.
- 8> Cape Breton Island - The island accounts for almost 19 percent of Nova Scotia's total area.
- 9> Morocco - Rabat is Morocco's second largest city.
- 10> Italy - The tower leans at about 3.99 degrees.
- 11> Columbia - Bogota is the capital and largest city of Columbia.
- 12> Caspian Sea - The Caspian Sea is the largest enclosed inland body of water on Earth by area.
- 13> Australia - The Gulf is 590 km wide at its mouth.
- 14> Red Sea and Mediterranean Sea - An artificial sea-level waterway, the Suez Canal was constructed between 1859 and 1869.
- 15> Atlas Mountains - The Atlas Mountains stretch for about 1,600 miles through Morocco, Algeria and Tunisia.
- 16> Iceland - Iceland has a population of 332,529.
