- 7> Alaska - Alaska is the largest state in the United States at over 660,000 square miles.
- 8> Monaco - Population density is given in people per sq. mile.
- 9> United Arab Emirates - The tallest skyscraper in the world is the Burj Khalifa Tower in Dubai, at 829.84 m (2,723 ft)
- 10> Famosa - Taiwan is 245 miles long and 144 89 miles wide.
