- 1> Mulligan - A mulligan is an extra stroke allowed after a poor shot, which is not counted on the scorecard.
- 2> Patty Berg - Patty had 15 major title wins, which is the all-time record for most major wins by a female golfer.
- 3> Royal and Ancient - The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews was founded in 1754.
- 4> Willie Anderson - Willie was the first golfer to win four U.S. Opens in 1901, 1903, 1904 and 1905.
- 5> Sand Wedge - The sand wedge is designed for use in sand bunkers.
- 6> American - Paul was in the top-10 of the Official World Golf Ranking between 1988 and 1994.
- 7> Tom Watson - At 65 years of age (2015), Tom now plays primarily on the Champions Tour.
- 8> 50 years - Established in 1980, the leading senior tour is the U.S. based Champions Tour.
- 9> Birmingham - The Belfry consists of three complete courses.
- 10> Betty Jameson - Betty was one of the thirteen founders of the LPGA in 1950.
- 11> Kookaburra - Kookaburra manufactures primarily cricket and hockey equipment.
- 12> Justin Rose - Justin was ranked in the World top-ten for 34 weeks between November 2007 and July 2008.
- 13> David Feherty - David currently works as broadcaster with CBS Sports.
- 14> 4 - The US Open was established in 1895.
- 15> Arnold - Palmer was nicknamed 'The King'.
