- 1> The Exorcist - Released in 1973, the Exorcist won two Academy Awards.
- 2> Janet Leigh - Directed by Alfred Hitchcock, Psycho is based on Robert Bloch's 1959 novel of the same name.
- 3> Insidious - The movie's story is quite similar to the 1982 classic horror film Poltergeist.
- 4> The Blair Witch Project - Receiving mostly positive reviews from critics, the Blair Witch Project grossed over 140 million in the US.
- 5> The Sixth Sense - Grossing over 293 million, Sixth Sense was nominated for six Oscars.
- 6> Hellraiser - Directed by Clive Barker, Hellraiser was released in 1987.
- 7> Ghost Story - Released in 1981, Ghost Story is the last film to feature Fred Astaire.
- 8> Cursed - Now a cult classic, Cursed was directed by Wes Craven.
- 9> Martha's Vineyard - Martha's Vineyard is an island located south of Cape Cod in Massachusetts.
- 10> Urban Legend - Urban Legend was followed by two sequels, Final Cut and Bloody Mary.
- 11> Creature from the Black Lagoon - Released in 1954, Creature from the Black Lagoon is scheduled to be remade sometime in the near future.
- 12> Vampire - Charlie is a character in the film Fright Night.
- 13> Tooth fairy - In this movie, a local town's woman, Matilda, is referred to as the Tooth Fairy.
