- 1> 4 - The four zones are salty, sweet, sour and bitter.
- 2> 14 - It takes 43 muscles to frown.
- 3> The jaw - The strongest muscle is the masseter muscle.
- 4> 32 - Children have 20 first teeth.
- 5> 230 - There are many kinds of joints including hinged, pivot, fused and ball and socket.
- 6> 60 - Men are about 60 percent and woman 55 percent.
- 7> 5 feet - The small intestines are about twenty-five feet long.
- 8> 4 - The heart is a hollow muscle, which pumps blood throughout the body.
- 9> 28 - There are 6 ear bones, 14 facial and 8 cranial.
- 10> Leg - The fibula is one of the bones in the lower leg.
- 11> Aorta - The aorta originates from the left ventricle of the heart.
- 12> Renal - The word renal comes from Latin.
- 13> Leukocytes - White blood cells help the body fight disease.
- 14> 23 - Twenty-two of these pairs are called autosomes.
- 15> Ear - This is a cone shaped membrane, which separates the middle ear and the external ear.
