- 3> Folsom Prison Blues - Released on the album 'With His Hot and Blue Guitar' in 1955.
- 4> Ring of Fire - Released on the album 'Ring of Fire - The Best of Johnny Cash' in 1963.
- 5> I've Been Everywhere - Originally made popular by Lucky Starr in 1962.
- 6> Ain't No Grave - Released posthumously on the album American VI - Ain't No Grave in 2010.
- 7> Sunday morning Coming Down - Released on the album 'The Johnny Cash Show' in 1970.
- 8> One - Originally recorded by U2 in 1992.
- 9> The Man Comes Around - Released on the album American IV - The Man Comes Around. It was one of the last songs Cash ever wrote.
- 10> Get Rhythm - Released as a single in September 1969.
- 11> A Boy Named Sue - Released on the album 'At San Quentin' in 1969.
- 12> Jackson - First recorded by Billy Edd Wheeler in 1963.
- 13> Don't Take Your Guns to Town - Released on the album 'The Fabulous Johnny Cash' in 1958.
- 14> Wayfaring Stranger - A well-known American folk song.
- 15> Ragged Old Flag - Released on the album 'Ragged Old Flag' in 1974.
