- 1> Marvin Gaye - I Heard It Through The Grapevine - Written by Norman Whitfield and Barrett Strong, Gaye released the song as a single in October 1968.
- 2> Mary Wells - My Guy - Released in 1964, My Guy was a number-one hit single for Mary Wells and the Motown label.
- 3> Temptations - Papa Was a Rollin' Stone - Released in 1972, the song can be found on the album All Directions.
- 4> Barrett Strong – Money (That's What I Want) - Released in 1960, Money (That's What I Want) was the first hit song for the Motown enterprise.
- 5> The Miracles - Shop Around - Released in 1961, the song can be found on the album Hi, We're the Miracles.
- 6> Jackson Five - I'll Be There - The Jackson 5 released I'll Be There as their first single from their album titled Third Album in 1969.
- 7> Stevie Wonder - Higher Ground - Released on Stevie's 1973 album Innervisions.
- 8> Supremes - You Can't Hurry Love - Released in 1966 on the album The Supremes A' Go-Go.
- 9> Marvelettes - Playboy - Released in 1962 on the album Playboy.
- 10> Lionel Richie - All Night Long (All Night) - Released in 1983 on the album Can't Slow Down.
- 11> Miracles - You've Really Got a Hold On Me - You've Really Got a Hold On Me received a 1998 Grammy Hall of Fame Award.
- 12> Rick James - Super Freak - Released in 1981 on the album Street Songs.
- 13> Temptations - My Girl - A number one hit in 1965, from the album The Temptations Sing Smokey.
- 14> Supremes - You Keep Me Hangin' On - Released in 1967 on the album The Supremes Sing Holland–Dozier–Holland.
- 15> Diana Ross - Love Hangover - Released in 1976 on the album Diana Ross.
