- 6> Jackson Five I'll Be There The Jackson 5 released I'll Be There as their first single from their album titled Third Album in 1969.
- 7> Stevie Wonder Higher Ground Released on Stevie's 1973 album Innervisions.
- 8> Supremes You Can't Hurry Love Released in 1966 on the album The Supremes A' Go-Go.
- 9> Marvelettes Playboy Released in 1962 on the album Playboy.
- 10> Lionel Richie All Night Long (All Night) Released in 1983 on the album Can't Slow Down.
