- 1> Pride and Prejudice - Released in 2005, Pride and Prejudice tells the story of five sisters from an English family.
- 2> No Country for Old Men - No Country for Old Men won four Oscars at the 2007 Academy Awards including Best Picture, Best Director and Best Adapted Screenplay.
- 3> Crash - Crash is about racial tensions in the city of Los Angeles.
- 4> Eddie Murphy - Shrek was loosely based on William Steig's fairy tale picture book 'Shrek!', which was published in 1990.
- 5> Christian Bale - The first movie in the Dark Knight trilogy, Batman Begins was primarily filmed in Iceland and Chicago.
- 6> WALL-E - WALL-E made over \$521.3 million worldwide and won the 2008 Golden Globe Award for Best Animated Feature Film.
- 7> Gladiator - Gladiator won five Academy Awards in total including Best Actor for Russell Crowe.
- 8> The Fellowship of the Ring - The Fellowship of the Ring (2001) was followed by The Two Towers (2002) and The Return of the King (2003).
- 9> Brokeback Mountain - Released in 2005, Brokeback Mountain was nominated for eight Academy Awards and won three.
- 10> Enemy at the Gates - Enemy at the Gates is loosely based on war stories told by the famous Soviet sniper Vasily Zaitsev.
- 11> Public Enemies - Released in 2009, the role of John Dillinger was played by Johnny Depp.
- 12> John Ford - John won best director Oscars for The Informer (1935), The Grapes of Wrath (1940), How Green Was My Valley (1941) and The Quiet Man (1952).
- 13> Crossfire Trail - Crossfire Trail was based on a Louis L'Amour Western novel of the same name.
- 14> Battle Royale - A classic worldwide, Battle Royale is one of the ten highest-grossing films in Japan.
