- 5> Ted Danson - Three Men and a Baby won the People's Choice Award in 1988.
- 6> Total Recall - The 1990 film Total Recall starred Arnold Schwarzenegger and Sharon Stone.
- 7> Dr. No - Appearing in the very first 007 film Dr. No.
- 8> Get Shorty - Get Shorty was based on a novel by Elmore Leonard of the same name.
- 9> The Book Thief - The movie is based on a novel of the same name by Markus Zusak.
