- 3> Performance - Released in 1970, Performance featured Jagger in his film-acting debut.
- 4> Chitty Chitty Bang Bang - Toot Sweets is sung by Dick Van Dyke and Sally Ann Howes.
- 5> Graham Chapman - Controversial at the time of its release, Life of Brian was banned by some countries.
- 6> The Lady Vanishes - Also titled The Lady Vanishes, a remake of the film was made in 1979.
- 7> A Fish Called Wanda - John Cleese stars as Archie Leach and Maria Aitken as Wendy Leach.
- 8> Albus Dumbledore - Richard Harris died shortly before the release of 'Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets' in 2002 at the age of 72.
- 9> A Clockwork Orange - A Clockwork Orange was listed by Time magazine as one of the 100 best English books in 2005.
- 10> King George VI - Directed by Tom Hooper, The King's Speech won seven Academy Awards including Best Picture.
- 11> Notting Hill - Julia Roberts plays the role of Hollywood film star Anna Scott.
- 12> Rain Man - Released in 1988, Rain Man won four Oscars at the 61st Academy Awards including Best Picture.
- 13> Sean Connery - Sean Connery played the character of Bond in seven Bond films.
- 14> Gandhi - Gandhi won eight Academy Awards including Best Picture.
- 15> The Hunger Games - Catching Fire - The Hunger Games - Catching Fire grossed over \$424 million.
