- 7> Robin Hood - According to legend, Robin Hood was a highly skilled archer and swordsman.
- 8> The Texas Chainsaw Massacre - Leatherface wears masks made from human skin.
- 9> Aladdin - Aladdin is based on the folktale of Aladdin and the magic lamp from One Thousand and One Nights.
- 10> The Silence of the Lambs - Released in 1991, The Silence of the Lambs won five Academy Awards including Best Picture, Best Actor and Best Actress.

- 15> Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs - Originally released in 1937, Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs was re-released to theaters in 1952, 1958, 1967, 1975, 1983, 1987 and 1993.
- 16> Jaws - Jaws was followed by three sequels.
- 17> One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest - Released in 1975, One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest won five Academy Awards including Best Picture, Best Actor and Best Actress.
- 18> The Wizard of Oz - Released in 1939, The Wizard of Oz is based on a 1900 novel of the same name by L. Frank Baum.
- 19> Psycho - First released in 1960, Psycho is based on a 1959 novel of the same name by Robert Bloch.
- 20> One Hundred and One Dalmatians - Originally released in 1961, One Hundred and One Dalmatians was the tenth highest grossing film of the year.
