- 1> B.J. Thomas - Heard in the 1969 movie Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid, the song was written by Burt Bacharach and Hal David.

- 3> Canada - Alanis was born in 1974 in Ottawa, Canada.
- 4> Anthony Ray - Ray was born in 1963.
- 5> Deee-Lite - The album's first single, "Groove Is in the Heart," was a number-one hit on the U.S. Hot Dance Club Play chart.
- 6> Imagine Dragons - Daniel Platzman is also a member of the band.
- 7> Pop Punk - The band was formed in Chicago in 2001.
- 8> 2 - This duo is from Orlando, Florida.
- 9> Bob Seger - Metallica covered the song on their 1998 Garage Inc. album.
- 10> Brian Adams - Recorded in Vancouver, Canada, the album was released in 1983.
