- 6> Baby One More Time - Baby One More Time was released by Britney Spears in 1990.
- 7> Eric Clapton - Change the World was written by Tommy Sims, Gordon Kennedy, and Wayne Kirkpatrick.
- 8> Spice Girls - The youngest member of Spice Girls, Bunton was known as Baby Spice.
- 9> Sheryl Crow - The song can be found on Kid Rock's album Cocky.
- 10> Don and Phil - The Everly Brothers were inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1986.
- 11> Johnny Ace - Johnny Ace was an American rhythm and blues singer who had string of hit singles before his death in 1954.
- 12> Grateful Dead - Garcia performed with the Grateful Dead for their entire thirty-year career from 1965 to 1995.
- 13> KISS - KISS was founded in January 1973 by Paul Stanley and Gene Simmons.
- 14> Highway to Hell - Highway to Hell was originally released on the 27th of July, 1979.
- 15> Guns N' Roses - As of 2015, Axl Rose is the only remaining original member still with Guns N' Roses.
- 16> The Doors - Led Zeppelin - Black Dog, Elvis - Hound Dog and Baha Men - Who Let the Dogs Out.
