- 1> Atlanta Rhythm Section - As of 2013, the band still maintains a website and tours with some of its original members.
- 2> Neil Sedaka - The song features a 20-second sax solo by Jim Horn.
- 3> Dokken - Ratt had success with songs such as 'Round and Round', 'Wanted Man', and 'Lay It Down'.
- 4> We Are the World - The song sold more than 20 million copies.
- 5> Mick Jagger and Keith Richards - Both men have taken jabs at each other in the press over the years, but they have always managed to smooth things over.
- 6> Chattanooga Choo Choo - 'Chattanooga Choo Choo' was written by Harry Warren and Mack Gordon.
- 7> Waylon Jennings - Richardson had contracted the flu during the tour and asked Waylon Jennings for his seat on the plane.
- 8> Ice Cube - Written and directed by John Singleton, Boyz n the Hood was released in 1991.
- 9> Lawrence Welk - Welk hosted the Lawrence Welk Show from 1955 to 1982.
- 10> How Sweet it is to be Loved by You - James Taylor's version of the song reached number one on the Easy Listening chart and number five on Billboard Hot 100.
- 11> Garbage - 'Stupid Girl' can be found on the band's self-titled debut studio album.
- 12> Phil Collins - Robert was the lead singer for the supergroup Led Zeppelin.
- 13> Waterloo - ABBA formed in Stockholm in 1972 and were active until 1982.
