4> Hound Dog - Elvis released his version of Hound Dog in July of 1956.

5> Geri Halliwell - The song was originally released by The Weather Girls in 1982.

6> Manic Street Preachers - Edwards was declared 'presumed dead' in November of 2008.

7> Pete Best - In August of 1962, Beatles manager Brian Epstein fired Pete Best and replaced him with Ringo Starr.

8> (Hit Me) Baby One More Time - First a single, the song was later released on the album ...Baby One More Time.

9> Avril Lavigne - From Avril Lavigne's album 'Let Go'.

10> Plain White T's - Plain White T's is best known for the number-one hit song 'Hey There Delilah'.

- 11> The Clowns - Recorded in 1958, the Clowns' most popular single was Don't You Just Know It.
- 12> Drums - Hawkins was the touring drummer for Alanis Morissette on her Jagged Little Pill and Can't Not Tours.
- 13> Fats Domino - Released on Fat's album This Is Fats Domino!
- 14> Jay Z - Numb/Encore is from the 2004 album Collision Course.
- 15> Touch - From their debut album Everytime We Touch.
- 16> Cello - Jacqueline's career was cut short by multiple sclerosis at the age of 27.
- 17> Sheryl Crow - 'All I Wanna Do' peaked at number two on the Billboard Hot 100.
- 18> All Saints - All Saints have sold over 12 million records
- 19> 14 - The song was originally written in honor of Marilyn Monroe in 1973.
- 20> The Clovers - The Clovers were one of the most popular acts of the 1950s.
