Answers:

- 1> Danica Patrick Danica was born in Beloit, Wisconsin. Her first sprint car race was the Daytona 500.
- 2> Charlotte Motor Speedway This race has been held every year at this track except in 1986 when it was staged at the Atlanta Motor Speedway.
- 3> Daytona 500 This race normally has the largest purse and is regarded as being the most prestigious.
- 4> 600 miles The longest race permitted is 600 miles. This race is normally run on Memorial Day.
- 5> Talladega Speedway The Talladega Speedway is the longest oval track, it is 2.66 miles. This track is located in Talladega, Alabama. There are longer road tracks.
- 6> Martinsville Speedway The Martinsville Speedway is a 0.526 oval track. The one at Bristol is a 0.533 course.
- 7> Martinsville Speedway This tradition began in 1964. This clock is supposed to chime America the Beautiful and God Bless America.
- 8> Dave Marcis Dave was born on the first of March, 1941. To date he has 33 Daytona starts.
- 9> 33 This is the normal number, although there have been exceptions. In 1979 and 1997, 35 cars started the race.
- 10> Jeff Gordon Jeff was born on August 4th 1971. He is a four time Sprint Cup Series winner.
- 11> Danica Patrick Patrick also appears on the show CSI NY and she has done her own voice on an episode of the Simpsons.
- 12> Harry Gant Harry won the race when he was 52 years old. His last race was in 1996, when he substituted for the injured Bill Elliot.
- 13> Kevin Conway Terry Cook and Landon Cassill were both runner-ups for the year.
- 14> Mark Martin Mark has been referred to as the best driver to never win a Championship. Mark Martin was born on the 9th of January 1959.
- 15> Ron Hornaday Jr. Ron has competed in all three NASCAR divisions. Both his father and his son are also racers.
- 16> Kansas Speedway This track is owned by the International Speedway Corporation. Two annual NASCAR races are held at this track.
