Answers:

1> Kyle Busch - The runners-up were Mike Garvey, Carl Long and Travis Kvapil.

2> 36 - There were also two exhibition races, which are not included in this figure. The season started on the 20th of February and ended on the 20th of November.

3> Dale Earnhardt Jr. - This award was first given in 1956. It is awarded in all three divisions.

4> Gil Martin - Gil works for Richard Childress. Gil has won all three divisions of NASCAR.

5> Arie Luyendyk - Arie turned in a lap time of 237.498 on the 12th of May. He did this during qualifying. He did have a faster practice time of 239. 260. However, practice runs are not official.

6> Richmond International Raceway - This trophy is over four feet tall. The guitar, which is designed by Paul Reed Smith Guitars, is fully functional.

7> Daytona Beach, Florida - They also have international offices located in Toronto and Mexico City.

8> Bill France Sr. - Bill started NASCAR in 1947-48. In 2009, the CEO of NASCAR was Brian France.

9> Danica Patrick - Danica is currently (2012) driving a car owned by Kelley Earnhardt-Mille.

10> Daytona International Speedway - Dale Earnhardt won 76 races before his untimely death in 2001.

11> Circuit Gilles Villeneuve - The other three tracks listed are ovals.

12> Phoenix International Raceway - This track in Arizona is a mile oval. The track is able to seat 76, 800 spectators.

13> Richard Petty - Richard Petty was driving a car during pace laps at the 2007 Pepsi 400 in Daytona.

14> Greg Sacks - This car is owned by Dale Earnhardt Jr.

15> Carl Edwards - Carl Edwards currently (2011) drives the #99 Fastenal.
