6> Montreal Wanderers - The Montreal Wanderers had their name placed on the inside of the cup in 1907.

7> Ian Morrison - Ian Morrison was appointed in 2002.

8> Dickie Moore - Richard Winston 'Dickie' Moore won the cup for the first time in 1953.

9> Ottawa Rideau Hall Rebels - One of Lord Stanley's sons was also involved in the formation of the Ontario Hockey Association.

10> 1963 - In 1963, the name of the team was spelled the Toronto Maple Leaes. 11> Adam Deadmarsh - This correction occurred in 1996.

12> Basil Pocklington - Team owner Peter Pocklington had his father's name put on the cup in 1984. Basil's name was covered over by 'Xs'.

13> Ted Kennedy - Ted Kennedy's name was spelled Ted Kennedyy.

14> Boston - In 1972, the word Boston was spelled Bqstqn.
