- 1> 1954 - Red Kelly of the Detroit Red Wings was the first recipient of the award.
- 2> Montreal - As of 2015, the NHL consists of 23 teams in the United States and 7 in Canada.
- 3> Mike Bossy - Mike played for the New York Islanders for his entire career.
- 4> Minnesota North Stars - The Minnesota North Stars were in the National Hockey League for 26 seasons, from 1967 to 1993.
- 5> Hartford Whalers - Bobby played for the Chicago Black Hawks, Winnipeg Jets and the Hartford Whalers.
- 6> Bobby Orr - Bobby started playing organized hockey at the age of five.
- 7> 85 by 200 feet - Every NHL game is played on a standard-size rink of 85 by 200 feet.
- 8> Chris Nilan - Chris won the Stanley Cup with Montreal in 1986.
- 9> John McMullen - John also owned the Houston Astros.
- 10> Madison Square Garden - Wayne played for 20 seasons in the NHL from 1979 to 1999.
- 11> Mike Bossy - Bossy is also one of only five players to score 50 goals in 50 games.
- 12> Sportsmanship - The Lady Byng Memorial Trophy was first awarded in 1925.
- 13> Washington Capitals - The Washington Capitals were founded in 1974.
- 14> Gordie Howe - Howe made his NHL debut with the Detroit Red Wings in 1946.
- 15> Billy Smith - Billy won four Stanley Cups with the New York Islanders.
- 16> Toronto Maple Leafs - Dated 1962-63, the team name is misspelled as TORONTO MAPLE LEAES.
- 17> Atlanta - In May of 2011, the Thrashers were moved to Winnipeg where they became the Winnipeg Jets.
- 18> 1929 - The offside rule requires that the puck precede attacking players across the opponent's blue line.
- 19> Bridgestone Arena - The Predators first took to the ice on October 10, 1998 where they lost to the Florida Panthers.
- 20> Walter Broda - Walter was inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame In 1967.
