- 6> Winter Wonderland Winter Wonderland was written by Felix Bernard and Richard Smith
- 7> **Deck the Halls** Mozart used the tune for Deck The Halls for a violin and piano duet.
- 8> Carol of the Bells Carol of the Bells is also sometimes called the Ukrainian Bell Carol.
- 9> Have Yourself a Merry Little Christmas The song was made famous in 1944 by Judy Garland in the film 'Meet Me in St. Louis'. 10> Rockin' Around the Christmas Tree Rockin' Around the Christmas Tree was written by Johnny Marks in 1958.
