- 9> Ecole Militaire in Paris Napoleon was the first Corsican to graduate from the prestigious school.
- 10> Austria During this battle in 1796, Napoleon was able to force the Austrian army out of Lombardy.
- 11> Marie-Louise Napoleon had been previously engaged to Julie before his marriage to Josephine.
- 12> His elder brother Napoleon named his elder brother Joseph-Napoleon Bonaparte King of Naples and then later King of Spain.
- 13> Beethoven Ludwig was disappointed with some of Napoleon's decisions and decided not to dedicate his third symphony to the Emperor.
- 14> Elba Island Elba Island is located in the Mediterranean.
- 15> He contracted tuberculosis Napoleon II died at the age of twenty-one.
- 16> Saint Helena Napoleon was exiled to Saint Helena in 1815, and it was here that he died.
