- 1> 1945 - Neil was born on November 12, 1945 in Toronto, Ontario.
- 2> Old Black - Neil acquired Old Black through a trade with Jim Messina in 1969.
- 3> Neil Young - The album failed to chart on the Billboard 200 album chart.
- 4> 1995 - Young was inducted into the Canadian Music Hall of Fame in 1982.
- 5> Buffalo Springfield - Buffalo Springfield was active from 1966 to 1968.
- 6> '68 - The film follows a Hungarian family that is living in San Francisco in 1968.
- 7> Down By the River - Released in 1969, Down by the River can be found on the album Everybody Knows This Is Nowhere.
- 8> 1 - Neil's song Heart of Gold charted at number one in March of 1972.
- 9> The Guess Who - The song was Young's first major success as a songwriter.
- 10> I Am a Child - I Am a Child appeared on Buffalo Springfield's third and last album, Last Time Around.
- 11> Harvest Moon - The album reached number 16 on the Billboard 200.
- 12> 3 - Neil has two sons and a daughter.
- 13> John Mellencamp - Farm Aid was set up to assist and increase awareness of the importance of family farms.
- 14> Harvest - Heart of Gold, among other hits, was released on the album.
- 15> Four Strong Winds - Four Strong Winds was written by Ian Tyson.
- 16> Walk On - From the album Freedom, Rockin' in the Free World was released in 1989.
- 17> Rust Never Sleeps - Rust Never Sleeps was released in July of 1979.
- 18> Long May You Run - Neil Young performed an acoustic version of the song.
- 19> Hurricane - A protest song, Hurricane was recorded by Bob Dylan in 1975.
- 20> Shadows and Light - Shadows and Light was released by Joni Mitchell in 1980.
- 21> Free World - Rockin' in the Free World was released on Neil's 1989 album Freedom.
- 22> A Man Needs a Maid - A Man Needs a Maid was released on the 1972 album Harvest.
