## Answers:

- 1> I Will Always Love You - This song was written by Dolly Parton and was released on her album Jolene. Whitney Houston did a cover of the song in the film 'The Bodyguard', which debuted in 1992.
- 2> Black or White - Recorded by Michael Jackson, the song appeared on Michael's eighth studio album Dangerous.
- 3> I Will Survive - This song appeared as the 'B-side' to the song Substitute. Disc jockeys started playing the 'B-side' and the song went to number one in 1979.
- 4> Escape - This song which topped the charts in 1979 was written by Rupert Holmes. It is often referred to as the Pina Colada song.
- 5> Starting Over - Written by John Lennon, the song is on his Double Fantasy album, which was released in 1980. The song became a number one hit in both the US and the UK two weeks after John was killed.
- 6> Bette Davis Eyes - Written by Jackie DeShannon and Donna Weiss, the song was released by Kim Carnes. It spent nine weeks at the top of the Billboard Hot 100.
- 7> Gold Digger - Appearing on Kanye West's second album Late Registration, it broke the record for being the most digitally downloaded song in 2005.
- 8> Umbrella - Written by Jay-Z, Umbrella was recorded by Rihanna. Featuring a verse done by Jay-Z., the song was released in 2007 and appeared on Rihanna's album Good Girl Gone Bad.
- 9> Firework - Found on Katy Perry's album Teenage Dream, the video for the song shows Katy dancing and singing in Budapest.
- 10> Poker Face - Recorded by Lady Gaga, the song appeared on her first album, The Fame , which was released in 2008. This song topped the charts all over in the world and reached number one in Canada, The UK, The US and elsewhere.
- 11> Womanizer - Released in 2006, this mega-hit was recorded by Britney Spears and is featured on her album Circus.
- 12> Touch My Body - Released in 2008, Mariah Carey wrote and recorded the song for her album Touch My Body.
- 13> Afternoon Delight - Released in 1976 by the Starland Vocal Band, the song was also a big hit for country singer Johnny Carver.
- 14> 50 Ways to Leave Your Lover - The song was written by Paul Simon shortly after he and his wife, Peggy Harper, had divorced. It can be found on Paul's album Still Crazy After All These Years, which came out in 1975.
- 15> Jump - Van Halen released this song in 1983. Eddie Van Halen has said that the solo on this song is the best one he NEVER wrote. The solo is actually a spliced compilation that was put together by the producer.
