4> Larisa Latynina - Larisa was a Russian gymnast. She has 18 Olympic medals.

5> Swimming - Michael is going to compete at the 2012 games.

6> Beijing - The games ran from August 8th to the 24th.

7> One World, One Dream - Every Olympic Game has a unique motto.

- 8> USA The USA has 1018 gold medals.
- 9> 776 BC The 'Stade' race was the only event.
- 10> Zeus To honor Zeus, 100 oxen were sacrificed.

11> USA - The USA has a combined total of 2548 medals.

12> Nine and Three-Fifth Seconds - The movie was released in 1925. It is about a sprinter.

13> White - The other two rings are green and yellow.

14> 2000 - It was stolen as a prank in 1920. The thief had the flag in his suitcase for 77 years.

15> Pierre de Coubertin - Coubertin remained honorary president of the IOC until his death in 1937.
