- 1> 4 - These suits are often called swords, cups, staves and pentacles.
- 2> Searching for water and hidden objects - Dowsers often use a "Y" shaped stick when they are dowsing.
- 3> Canada - One theory states that the entrance to Hollow Earth is located in Antarctica.
- 4> UFO - In 1965, a UFO was sighted by thousands across six states and in Canada. Residents of Kecksburg claimed that the object crashed near their town.
- 5> They are always seen in pairs - White ladies have been the subject of a number of famous paranormal photographs.
- 6> 1946 - German newspapers reported another crash landing near the town in 1952 as well.
- 7> Two formations of red-orange objects - This sighting occurred in February 2009. More of these objects were seen in March 2009.
- 8> Elizabeth Klarer - The book is about Elizabeth's alleged alien abduction.
- 9> New Hampshire - This alleged incident happened in 1961.
- 10> Congo River - The creature has been the subject of a number of books and movies. However, no one has ever been able to get a picture of the animal.
- 11> Aliens - Declared to be completely bogus by the FBI, these documents are also sometimes referred to as the Majestic 12 documents.
- 12> The Jersey Devil - This creature is said to inhabit the Pine Barrens of New Jersey.
- 13> Rabbits - After an intense investigation, Mary eventually confessed to being a fraud.
- 14> Norway - Selma is said to live in Lake Seljordsvatnet.
- 15> Bed - He bought the bed for his son.
