- 2> American Horror Story - American Horror Story was created and produced by Ryan Murphy and Brad Falchuk.
- 3> Whole Lotta Love - Whole Lotta Love was released by Led Zeppelin on the LP Led Zeppelin II in October of 1969.
- 4> The Bridge on the River Kwai - The Bridge on the River Kwai is based on an eponymous 1952 novel by Pierre Boulle.
- 5> Joe Rogan - The show was revived in 2011 for an additional eight episodes.
- 6> Tetris - Tetris sold 35 million copies.
- 7> I Walk the Line - Johnny Cash - I Walk the Line was on the record charts for over 43 weeks, and sold over 2 million copies.
- 8> Cool Hand Luke - 'Frankly, my dear, I don't give a damn' from Gone With the Wind is listed as the number one movie line of all time.
- 9> Jerry Rice - As of 2014, Jerry holds over 100 NFL records, more than any other player.
