Answers:

1> Julia R - The waitress is named Julia R, for Julia Roberts, who plays Erin Brockovich.

3> Klinger - He married a Korean woman, despite spending the war trying to get home.

4> Sean Connery - This was in Indiana Jones & the Last Crusade and in Family Business.

5> James Dean - Dean had nicknamed the car Little Bastard.

6> Eddie Murphy - He played Donkey in Shrek and the dragon Mushu in Mulan.

7> Snagglepuss - 'Heavens to Murgatroyd' was the catchphrase of Burt Lahr's character in the 1944 movie Meet the People. Baron Murgatroyd was a Gilbert and Sullivan character.

8> Jordan - As he wasn't a member of the Screen Actors Guild, he was not allowed to have any lines.

9> Rob Reiner - It is considered one of the funniest movie lines ever.

10> The Black Panther - He was T'Challa, the King of Wakanda.

11> Christopher Lee - Strictly speaking, Fleming was his step-cousin once removed. Lee had been considered for the role of Doctor No.
