**Answers:**

1> Four Seasons - 'Bye, Bye, Baby' stayed at #1 on the UK charts for six weeks in 1975. It sold almost a million copies.

2> Earth Song - 'Earth Song' is the 3rd single from Michael Jackson's album HIStory - Past, Present and Future, Book I

3> The Immaculate Collection - The Immaculate Collection was released on November 9, 1990 by Sire Records.

4> Charlotte Church - Tissues and Issues was released in 2005 and is the fifth studio album by the Welsh singer.

5> Fairbrass - Right Said Fred has sold over 4 million records worldwide.

6> Sunny Afternoon - The song can be found on the Kink's 1966 Face To Face album.

7> Aretha Franklin - Otis Redding wrote and originally recorded 'Respect' in 1965.

8> Elvis Costello - Elvis' first single was 'Less Than Zero', which was released on the 25th of March 1977.

9> Iron Maiden - Eddie can be found in the first-person shooter video game, Ed Hunter.

10> Michael Jackson - Released on the Motown label, it was Micheal's first solo single after leaving The Jackson 5.

11> The Smiths - The song peaked at number ten on the UK Singles Chart in June 1984.

12> The Righteous Brothers - The Righteous Brothers recorded from 1963 to 1975, and performed until 2003 when Hatfield died.

13> Australia - AC/DC formed in 1973 by brothers Malcolm and Angus Young.

14> Bat Out of Hell - Meat Loaf was born as Marvin Lee Aday on September 27th, in 1947.

15> The Hollies - The Hollies have never officially broken up and still continue to record and perform today.
