4> 2008 - 2009 - The songs were 'Radio Nowhere' and 'Girls in Their Summer Clothes'.

5> Come to My Window - On September 27, 2011, Melissa received her own star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame.

6> House of Cards - It was nominated for Best Rock Performance by a Duo or Group with Vocal, Best Rock Song and Best Short Form Music Video.

7> Icky Thump - The song was written by Jack White.

8> What I've Done - The song was released as a radio single on April 1, 2007.

9> Vertigo - Vertigo received widespread airplay and was an international hit.

10> Evanescence - "Bring Me to Life" was included as part of the Daredevil soundtrack.

11> Drops of Jupiter (Tell Me) - Pat Monahan said that the song was inspired by the death of his mother.

12> Creed - Creed reunited in 2009 to record a new album called Full Circle.

13> Untied States - The band formed in Los Angeles in 1983.

14> The Wallflowers - The Wallflowers formed in 1989 and were originally known as The Apples.

15> The Smashing Pumpkins - The Smashing Pumpkins formed in Chicago, Illinois in 1988.
