4> Bryan Adams - '18 til I Die' is Bryan's seventh studio album, released on June 4, 1996.

5> Lenny Kravitz - It was included in the 1999 re-issue of his 5 album.

6> Oasis - Oasis broke-up in 2009.

7> Radiohead - Radiohead were ranked number 73 in Rolling Stone's list of "The Greatest Artists of All Time".

8> Released for free under Creative Commons - With the message from Trent Reznor, 'this one is on me'.

9> Queer - Released on November 20, 1995.

10> Hurt - It was one of Johnny's final hit releases before his death.

11> Misery - 'Misery', reached number one on the Modern Rock Tracks chart in the US.

12> Goo Goo Dolls - The video was an assemblage of footage from the Buffalo area played to the song 'Better Days'.

13> The Cranberries - The Cranberries formed in Limerick in 1989

14> Smash Mouth - 'Walkin' on the Sun' spent five weeks at number-one on the Billboard magazine Modern Rock Tracks chart.

15> Celebrity Skin - Hole formed after guitarist Eric Erlandson replied to an ad placed by Courtney Love in a punk-rock magazine.
