4> Pork and Beans - The song spent eleven weeks at number one on the Billboard chart.

5> Psycho - The song was released on October 2, 2007.

6> Linkin Park - Hybrid Theory has sold 24 million copies worldwide.

7> How You Remind Me - The song was released in July 2001.

8> Sum 41 - Sum 41 originated from Ajax, Ontario.

9> Cleveland, Ohio - The Rock and Roll Hall of Fame was established April 20, 1983.

10> Donovan - Donovan has stated the Bob Dylan was an important influence early in his career.

11> Vincent Furnier - Vincent was born February 4, 1948.

12> Chrissie Hynde - The Pretender's debut album entitled, Pretenders was released in January 1980.

13> Phil Spector - Phil Spector was inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1989.

14> Pete Townshend - Pete Townshend is best known as the guitarist and songwriter for the rock group The Who.

15> Eric Clapton - Once as a solo artist, and separately as a member of The Yardbirds and Cream.
