- 5> Barenaked Ladies - Barenaked Ladies is from Toronto, Canada.
- 6> Destiny's Child - An all girl group, whose members included Beyonce and Kelly Rowland, they were called Girls Tyme on the show.
- 7> Iron Maiden - Iron Maiden was part of the 'Acid Rock' era.
- 8> Steve Tyler - Aerosmith was formed in 1970.
- 9> Billy Joel - Billy Joel is a classically trained musician.
- 10> Scotland - Nazareth was formed in 1968. One of its founding members was Dan McCafferty.
- 11> Don't Come Around Here No more - Released in February of 1985, the song can be found on Tom Petty's 1985 album, Southern Accents.
- 12> Stage Fright - The band members of Genesis included Peter Dinklage, Phil Collins and John Silver.
- 13> Herman's Hermits - Herman's Hermits had many hits in the US and UK from 1964 to 1969.
- 14> Torrence - Jan Berry and Dean Torrence started recording in 1958.
- 15> Limp Bizkit - Limp Bizkit comes from Jacksonville, Florida.
- 16> Moody Blues - The Blues include Denny Lane and Mike Pinder.
