- 3> David Lee Roth David Farnsworth David Lee Roth (his birth name) was inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 2007.
- 4> Monterey Pop Festival Rolling Stone magazine ranked Hendrix as the greatest guitarist of all time.
- 5> The Blue Velvets The Blue Velvets released three singles in 1961 and 1962. None of them were successful.
- 6> Plasmatics Williams died on April 6, 1998 at the age 48 from a self-inflicted gunshot wound.
- 7> 1977 Ronnie Van Zant, Steve Gaines, Cassie Gaines, assistant road manager Dean Kilpatrick and the pilots were killed in the crash.
- 8> Cleveland, OH The Rock and Roll Hall of Fame began on April 20, 1983.
- 9> Roxy Music The song can be found on Roxy Music's fifth studio album Siren.
- 10> Keep Yourself Alive Rolling Stone magazine rated the song 31st on its list of 'The 100 Greatest Guitar Songs of All Time' in 2008.
- 11> Sam the Sham and the Pharaohs Wooly Bully sold over three million copies and reached No. 2 on the American Hot 100 chart in 1965.
- 12> In Grammar School The Rolling Stones celebrated their 50th anniversary in 2012.
- 13> The Guess Who The Guess Who formed in Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada in 1965.
- 14> Alanis Morrissette In 1996, Morissette won five Grammy awards including album of the year.
- 15> Peter Crisscoula Peter has released six solo albums.
