- 4> Stargate SG-1 - Stargate SG-1 lasted for 214 episodes (over 10 seasons).
- 5> The Promised Planet - The Promised Planet was episode 19 from season 3.
- 6> Rod Serling - CBS broadcast the first episode of Serling's series, The Twilight Zone, on October 2, 1959.
- 7> Milk - Alien Nation ran for one season, from 1989 through 1990.
- 8> Wolf-Wolf - Butch Patrick originally played Eddie Munster.
- 9> Smallville - Smallville is the longest running comic book-based series in television history.
- 10> Bruce Lee - The Green Hornet was created by George W. Trendle and Fran Striker.
- 11> Martin Landau and Catherine Schell - Space 1999 originally aired from 1975 to 1977.
- 12> Linda Hunt - Released in 1993, the series was about a small police force at Planet Avalon's Fort Hope in 2104.
- 13> 13th - Forever Knight was about an 800-year-old vampire working as a police detective in modern day Toronto.
- 14> Miniature Pellet Projection Tube - Time Trax ran from January 20, 1993 to December 3, 1994.
- 15> Gil Gerard - In 2007, Gil and his Buck Rogers co-star Erin Gray reunited for the TV movie Nuclear Hurricane.
