- 1> Lorne Greene - Lorne also played the role of Ben Cartwright on the western TV show Bonanza.
- 2> Five hundred - Many of the props, effects and costumes seen on the show were recycled from Battlestar Galactica.
- 3> Yale - Earth 2 was canceled after one season of 22 episodes.
- 4> John Koenig - John Koenig was played by Martin Landau.
- 5> Tiberius - James T. Kirk was the commanding officer of the USS Enterprise.
- 6> Gabrielle Drake - Gabrielle Drake's brother was the musician Nick Drake.
- 7> Dark Room - Dark Room ran for 16 episodes from November 27, 1981 to January 15, 1982.
- 8> Kevin Sorbo - The show ran for 6 seasons.
- 9> 2063 - The show was originally to run for five seasons, but was cancelled after the first season (1995–1996).
- 10> Number 2 - The Prisoner ran for 17 episodes in the UK from 29 September 1967 to 1 February 1968.
- 11> New Zealand - Xena - Warrior Princess was a spin-off of the TV series Hercules - The Legendary Journeys. It ran for 6 seasons - 134 episodes.
- 12> Richard Bull - Broadcast during the 1960's, the show starred Richard Basehart and David Hedison.
- 13> 1988 - At the start of the third season, the show was renamed to 'The Adventures of Superboy'.
- 14> The Mojave Desert - Alien Nation ran from September 18, 1989 to May 7, 1990.
- 15> Sliders - Cleavant Derricks was the only cast member to stay with the series throughout its entire five season run.
