## Answers:

- 1> 6 - The countries bordering South Africa are Namibia, Botswana, Zimbabwe, Mozambique, Swaziland and Lesotho.
- 2> Johannesburg - JSE was founded in 1887 after the discovery of gold on the Witwatersrand.
- 3> Durban - The third busiest container port in the Southern Hemisphere, the Port of Durban was formerly known as the Port of Natal.
- 4> Thabo Mbeki - Mbeki served from 1999-2008, when he resigned.
- 5> Johannesburg - Johannesburg is the world's largest city not situated on a river, lake, or coastline.
- 6> Pretoria - Within South Africa Pretoria is popularly known as the Jacaranda City due to the thousands of Jacaranda trees planted in its streets, parks and gardens.
- 7> .za - .sa is the country code for Saudi Arabia.
- 8> Bisho - Under its former name Bisho, the town was the capital of Ciskei, a territory set aside for black inhabitants of South Africa and South West Africa (now Namibia) as part of the policy of Apartheid.
- 9> Gauteng - Gauteng contains the country's largest city, Johannesburg, and its administrative capital, Pretoria.
- 10> Johannesburg - Since 2004 the court has occupied a purpose-built complex on Constitution Hill.
- 11> 9 - Western Cape, Eastern Cape, Northern Cape, North West, Free State, Kwazulu Natal, Gauteng, Limpopo and Mpumalanga.
- 12> 1,550 miles - South Africa is the 25th-largest country in the world.
