## Answers:

- 1> Lacrosse - Lacrosse used to be played 3 days straight in a field up to 3km long.
- 2> Michael Phelps - Michael Phelps won 16 Olympic medals, out of which 14 are gold.
- 3> Great Britain - The three are Tour de France, Giro d'Italia and Vuelta a Espana.
- 4> Approx. 82 kilometers - Double Ultra Triathlon also includes 7.6 km of swimming and 360 km of cycling.
- 5> Rogers Cup - French Open is played on clay, Wimbledon – on grass, and Australian Open – on hard court.
- 6> Golf - Tiger Woods started playing golf before he reached the age of two.
- 7> Scotland - Curling used to be played with stones on ice.
- 8> Bone - The first ice skates were neither as sharp nor fast.
- 9> Cricket - Although cricket is the most popular sport, the official sport of India is football.
- 10> A trophy - Lord Stanley's Mug is also known as the Stanley Cup, the most desired ice hockey trophy.
- 11> 50 meters - The size of the target varies accordingly to the shooter's position, prone or standing.
- 12> A type of skiing - Skijoring is a sport where an animal pulls the skier, usually a horse or a few dogs.
- 13> Heptathlon - Heptathlon includes running, throwing and jumping.
- 14> Usain Bolt - The current speed record for 100 meters is 9.58 seconds.
- 15> Ice-skating - Crashed Ice takes place every year in Quebec City, Canada.
