14> Radioactive Man - Created by Morty Mann for the Simpsons universe.

15> The Comet - First appeared in Pep Comics #1 in (January 1940)

16> Plasticman - First appeared in Police Comics #1 (August 1941)

17> The Flash - The original Flash first appeared in Flash Comics #1 (January 1940)

18> Green Lantern - The original Green Lantern (Alan Scott) first appeared in All-American Comics #16 (July 1940)
