- 1> Julianna Margulies - The series has won a number of awards including a Primetime Emmy Award for Julianna Margulies.
- 2> Saturday Night Live - As of 2014, Saturday Night Live has forty. Frasier has thirty-seven.
- 3> The Wire - The Wire made its debut in June 2002 and ran for five seasons.
- 4> Deadwood - Deadwood had 28 Emmy Award nominations and won eight.
- 5> The West Wing - The series ended, after airing for seven seasons, in May of 2006.
- 6> David Duchovny - Popular, the X-Files spanned 9 seasons and 202 episodes.
- 7> Loni Anderson - WKRP aired for 4 seasons and 88 episodes.
- 8> Gilmore Girls - The show won one Emmy Award during its seven-season run.
- 9> Wonder Woman - Wonder Woman was based on the DC Comic series of the same name.
- 10> That Girl - Sally was inducted into the American Academy of Arts and Sciences in 2013.
- 11> Justified - As of 2014, Justified has been nominated for seven Primetime Emmy Awards and won two.
- 12> Laverne and Shirley - Laverne and Shirley ran from January 27, 1976 to May 10, 1983.
- 13> Cheers - Cheers won 28 Emmy Awards during its eleven-season run.
- 14> Mork and Mindy - Robin died on August 11, 2014 of asphyxiation.
- 15> Justin Berfield - Breaking Bad was one of the most-watched cable shows of all-time.
