- 3> Real Estate Agent - TV Guide named Seinfeld the greatest television series of all time in 2002.
- 4> The Price is Right - Cullen hosted the show from 1956 to 1965.
- 5> Falling Skies - The show stars Noah Wyle as Tom Mason.
- 6> A Thumb - Phoebe received compensation of seven thousand dollars.
- 7> Jan - The show aired on ABC between 1976 to 1977.
- 8> James Dean - James is buried in Park Cemetery in Fairmount, Indiana.
