- 4> The Golden Palace - They hire Chuy Castillos (Cheech Marin) to handle the kitchen and Roland Wilson (Don Cheadle) to run the front desk.
- 5> Scrubs - Sacred Heart was said to be located in San DiFrageles. It was actually a decommissioned hospital in San Fernando Valley.
- 6> Niles and Daphne - Niles' wife at the time wasn't Maris, but Mel Karnofsky.
- 7> Rachel and Monica on 'Friends' - You finally saw his naked back when Ross made a play for his apartment.
- 8> Emily Weston - She became a series regular for a single season. (The others are characters on Charmed.)
- 9> Richard Branson - Shawn Nelson, the founder of LoveSac Corporation, theoretically was picked to succeed Branson as president of Virgin Worldwide.
- 10> MXC - The original show involved people trying to seize a castle. Most Extreme Elimination Challenge reused the footage.
- 11> Her father, Leland - Although Dad was possessed (or something) by a malevolent spirit called Bob.
- 12> Coupling - The US version was pulled after four episodes.
- 13> One Tree Hill - The teen show was set in Tree Hill, North Carolina.
- 14> The Contender - Sergio Mora won, but one of the people he beat, Najai Turpin, killed himself.
