- 3> Strawberry Fields Forever According to Lennon, the song Strawberry Fields Forever was about his memories of playing in the garden of a Salvation Army house named 'Strawberry Field'.
- 4> Yesterday Yesterday was originally recorded by the Beatles for their 1965 album Help!
- 5> George Harrison Each of the Beatles' albums included one or two of Harrison's compositions.
- 6> Good Day Sunshine McCartney later said that the song was influenced by The Lovin' Spoonful's hit song 'Daydream'.
- 7> Two of Us McCartney said that the song was dedicated to his wife-to-be Linda Eastman.
- 8> John According to John, his father only turned up after he was famous.
- 9> Yesterday and Today Capital records didn't like the cover and 'pasted' a new cover over it. It is now a highly sought item by collectors.
- 10> 11 The album Yellow Submarine reached position 3.
- 11> She Loves You She Loves You was on the charts for 33 weeks.
- 12> 1988 EMI Records estimate that the Beatles have sold over one billion records worldwide.
- 13> Elvis Presley Other early influences included Eddie Cochran, Roy Orbison and the Everly Brothers.
- 14> I Saw Her Standing There Please, Please Me was voted 39th on Rolling Stone magazine's list of the '500 Greatest Albums of All Time' in 2012.
- 15> Let It Be It was released on 8 May 1970 by the band's Apple Records label.
