7> Waylon - Smithers is an obedient assistant to Mr. Burns.

8> Malibu Stacy - The name Stacy was derived from the name of the facial mold used by Mattel for its 1971 Malibu Barbie.

9> Blinky - Blinky the Three-Eyed Fish makes a brief cameo in this episode and again in the second season.

10> France - Principal of Springfield Elementary School, Skinner is a strict disciplinarian.

11> Barry White - A statement against the mistreatment of snakes, the episode won a Genesis Award.

12> Fat Tony - They are members of the Springfield mafia.

13> Apu - Apu is the owner of the Kwik-E-Mart, a convenience store in Springfield.

14> Sideshow Bob - Gino Terwilliger is the toddler son of Sideshow Bob.

15> Homer - Airing during the eleventh season, Ron Howard guest starred as himself in the episode.
