Answers:

- 1> Lake Super - Lake Erie and Lake Huron are both Great Lakes. Lake Super is NOT. Lake Superior is one of the Great Lakes as well as Lake Ontario and Lake Michigan.
- 2> Virginia - Montana is across the U.S. and though New York is close, it does not touch DC. DC is also adjacent to Maryland.
- 3> California - Maine touches the Atlantic Ocean and Kentucky is not touching any oceans.

- 4> South Dakota - The capital of South Carolina is Columbia and the capital of Vermont is Montpelier.
- 5> Kansas - The Missouri River also flows through Missouri, Montana, South and North Dakota, Nebraska, and Iowa.
- 6> Baton Rouge - Although Baton Rouge is the capital, it is not the largest city. New Orleans is the biggest city in Louisiana.
- 7> Florida - Florida was not one of the original colonies. Delaware was the 10th colony and Georgia was the 13th.
- 8> Maui - Maui is one of the 8 main Hawaiian Islands.
- 9> Northern U.S. - Minnesota is Mid North. It lies near Wisconsin and the Dakotas.
- 10> Greenville - All of these are in numerous states, however, Greenville can be found in the MOST states with a total of 49!
