- 6> The Comedy of Errors The Comedy of Errors is about two sets of identical twins that were accidentally separated at birth.
- 7> France Henry V is a history play that was written somewhere around 1599.
- 8> The Two Noble Kinsmen The Two Noble Kinsmen was first published in 1634.
- 9> Banquo The Tragedy of Macbeth was written sometime between 1599 and 1606.
- 10> Malvolio Malvolio is the steward of Olivia's household in the play, Twelfth Night.
- 11> The Tempest Gene Roddenberry stated that Forbidden Planet was one of his inspirations for Star Trek.
- 12> Henry VIII The play is based on the life of Henry VIII of England.
- 13> Britain The first recorded production of Cymbeline was in April 1611.

- 15> Verona Romeo and Juliet was one of Shakespeare's most popular plays during his lifetime.
